In this book, gospel(ed) is more than a noun or even an adjective—it is a verb that suggests how we live after we have an encounter with Christ. Books are \$8. Steve Strong is the facilitator.

2) "Psalmist's Cry" - 5:30-6:45 PM Tuesdays beginning Feb. 28, in the Sanctuary. This study by Brueggemann and Frost invites you to focus on spiritual healing rather than on maintaining rigid control over your life.
